Philosophy & History

Philosophy and history – FlexSchool is specially designed for gifted and twice-exceptional (2e) students in grades 5–12 and post-graduate (NJ, NY) and 2–12, PG (100% live remote campus). Small, ability-based liberal arts classes taught ensure meaningful conversations, in-depth analysis, extensive experiments, and the opportunity to ask high-level questions. Talent development and academic choice are emphasized, with support for challenges as necessary. Every Friday each campus has a field trip, speaker, program, or experiential learning opportunity to augment academic subjects and provide a rich fund of knowledge for students who are very creative and resourceful; our students are especially good at synthesizing information across disciplines and finding patterns.

Academics

FlexSchool is a liberal arts middle and high school for gifted and twice-exceptional students. Gifts are emphasized and learning challenges are supported as necessary. All admitted students are intellectually curious and able to conduct in-depth analysis in a discussion-based class. Students may attend either in person or through Zoom conferencing via our Cloud Campus. All courses are taught at the honors or high honors level, and the workload is adjusted to the needs of the students to allow for acceleration, more depth, and possible alternate assessments. Students are placed in classes by ability rather than age. While FlexSchool does not offer AP courses, teachers cover materials and many students take AP exams.

Core Academic Requirements

- FlexSchool high school students are expected to complete a minimum of 20 academic credits in core subject areas (English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and World Languages) to earn a FlexSchool diploma.
